Projects should have been completed within the last two years and can include:

New buildings – residential, community, educational, commercial: or

Alterations to an existing building – extensions, refurbishments, conversions or restorations.

We would ask you to consider the following aspects when making a nomination:

Quality – is it of the highest quality in terms of its design, materials used or construction?

Visual Amenity – how well do the alterations relate to the existing building and for a new building does it compliment the neighbourhood?

Innovation – is it an original solution to design or construction problems?

Sustainability – does the project promote environmental issues such as the use of recycled materials, alternative energy sources, waste management and water saving?
