Two groups of Loughton Wombles were out on Saturday 20 April 2024. One group were busy litter picking in Rookwood Avenue and followed the brook to the M11 motorway and the other in Oakwood Hill between Marlescroft Way and the traffic lights at Chigwell Lane.



Three fly-tipped tyres were collected. As well as being unsightly, they are dangerous and costly to clear up. They are hazardous if caught on fire as they release toxic

chemicals. Loughton Town Council (LTC) waste carriers are not able to dispose of them, if collected on our litter picks. LTC will have to notify Epping Forest District Council (EFDC) of the exact location for them to be collected. This can be organised by the LTC office.



Our next litter pick will be Saturday 25 May 2024. Meeting points will be advised week commencing 20 May. Please let us know of any target areas you notice when you are out and about. I have already been advised of a couple of areas in need of our attention, but I'll check them on the week leading up to the day.
