

Loughton Residents Celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III 6 – 8 May 2023

Loughton Town Mayor is encouraging residents to start planning their own street parties for The Coronation of The King and The Queen Consort, **deck Loughton with bunting!**

The Town Council has bought and has organised for bunting to be put up in both The Broadway, and Loughton High Road, “we encourage all residents and businesses to also bedeck their premises with bunting, flags and balloons”.

The Town Mayor will take an official tour of the Town and photographs will be taken of the best dressed businesses, houses, properties and streets. These will be included in a Coronation feature in the next Think Loughton. The Coronation will be celebrated across the country and marked with a three-day bank holiday weekend from Saturday 6 May to Monday 8 May with opportunities for our residents to be part of this historic occasion.

Holding a small outside event with neighbours, on private land, does not need council permission. However, if you plan a street party that involves the closure of a public road, you will need to check the road is suitable.

If you're planning a street party, you will need to apply for a temporary road closure, Epping Forest District Council can help with that, [Advice on Coronation street parties - Epping Forest District Council \(eppingforestdc.gov.uk\)](https://www.eppingforestdc.gov.uk)

There are no costs for road closure applications, and we encourage residents to apply. You need to apply by 31 March.
