Loughton residents are invited to join our team of volunteers to help keep the pavements and roads close to their homes safe during periods of snow and ice.

With over 2,000 miles of roads in Essex, the County Council concentrates its efforts on the most important routes clear to keep everyone moving; these include A and B roads and those with a frequent bus service. They are unable to salt the majority of residential estate roads and rural lanes. The main arteries across the county, the A12, A120, M11 and M25 are maintained by the Highways Agency.
